Defend Striking IAM Henkel Workers

Whereas, 84 IAM Local 1584 workers at Henkel Aerospace went on out strike at the Bay Point, California, plant on October 16, 2017, and

Whereas, a 26-year-old temporary worker, David Eleidjian, was pulled into a machine and killed due to the lack of training and because of the violation of health and safety rules, and

Whereas, as a result of the lack of enforcement of health and safety regulations by the company, there have been continuous injuries, and workers have been faced with serious burns, and

Whereas, Henkel Aerospace, which is based in Germany, has brought in Strom Engineering to replace striking workers with scabs in order to break the strike and the union.

Therefore be it resolved, that the Binational Conference condemns the union-busting, violation of health and safety rules, and strike-breaking by the Henkel company and calls on all workers and their unions around the world to take action and build solidarity in support of the striking Henkel Aerospace workers.
